- Workforce Development	\$2,871,969	Capital Area Workforce Development Board has received funding for youth employment and dislocated worker program
- Homelessness Prevention	\$1,573,255	City of Raleigh (\$991k) and Wake County (\$582k) for a program to assist families who have been recently displaced
- Food Stamps	\$1,520,527	As outlined in Powerpoint
- Community Services Block Grant	\$1,378,455	When designated, the new Wake County Community Service Agency will receive this funding along with the regular appropriation of State funding
- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)	\$1,151,282	Additional CDBG funding was given to Wake County (380,721), City of Raleigh (648,128) and Town of Cary (122,433)
- Crime Control	\$1,090,257	Funding to Various Law Enforcement Agencies through the Byrne Justice Assistance Grant
- Clean Water	\$465,735	Rainwater harvesting by City of Raleigh for reused water
- School Lunch Equipment	\$90,933	Wake County Public Schools
- Drinking Water	\$81,600	Town of Holly Springs Solar powered mixing system for better water quality
