Spring Broke by Melody Carlson

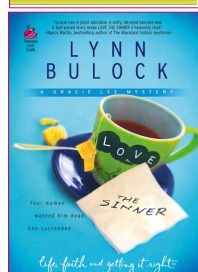
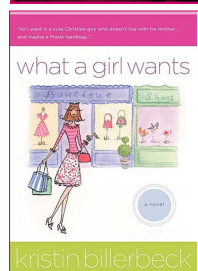
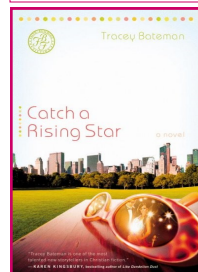
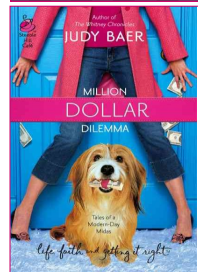

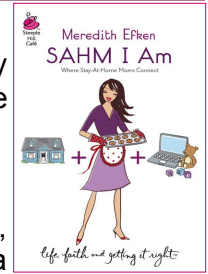
Consider Lily by Anne Dayton

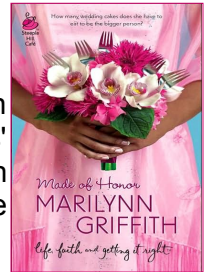


Flippin' the Script by Aisha Ford

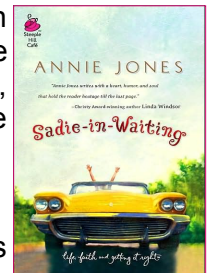


Sisterchicks on the Loose by Robin Jones Gunn

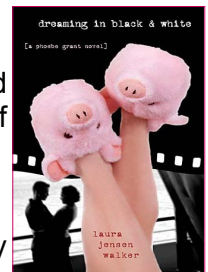


Tiger Lillie by Lisa Samson
