Phineas L. Macguire – Blasts Off!

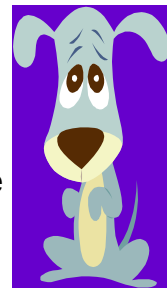

Forget Me Not: From the Life of Willa Havisham

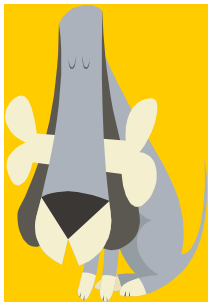
