Consumer Co-Pay Schedule
Effective July 1, 2007

The Co-Pays listed below apply to Non-Medicaid services authorized by Wake County LME. Clinical or Financial Hardship exceptions may be requested for consumers with fees. Consumers may also apply for Financial Hardship when their out-of-pocket cost has reached 5% of their gross income for the calendar year.

The consumer is not eligible for public subsidy of service cost when:

- The consumer's household income is over 400% of poverty (exceptions may be requested).
- The consumer is not a Wake County resident (exception for special regional "CASP" service recipients).
- The consumer refused to apply for Reduced Fee.
- The Application for Reduced Fee was incomplete.
- The consumer does not meet diagnostic and clinical criteria.

Eligible consumers may not receive authorization if funding is unavailable or there is a waiting list for services.
