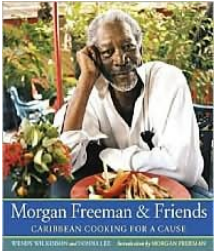
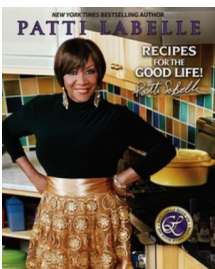

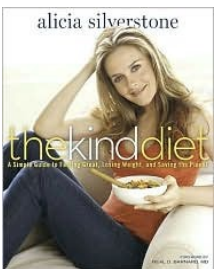


Morgan Freeman and Friends: Caribbean Cooking for a Cause by Wendy Wilkinson and Donna Lee (641.5 WILKI)

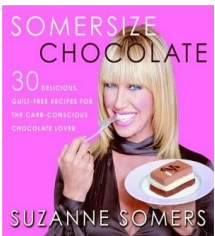
Recipes for the Good Life by Patti LaBelle with Judith Choate and Karen Hunter (641.597 LABEL)

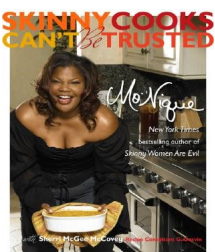
The Kind Diet: A Simple Guide to Feeling Great, Losing Weight, and Saving the Planet by Alicia Silverstone (641.5 SILVE)
