K-8 FEED THE BIN Teacher Training

Building upon environmental education developed by Wake County Solid Waste Management Division and partners, this training provides K-8 teachers with the tools they need to educate students about solid waste issues.

The 10 hour training will focus on FEED THE BIN: a varied program of curriculum linked lesson plans, presentations, teacher resources and student incentives; tailored to varying grade levels.

- Review lesson plans on recycling, buying recycled, landfills, plastics, litter, and compost. FEED THE BIN lessons are correlated to the NC Standard Course of Study.
- Receive a lesson plan manual and teacher resource samples for grades K-8.
- Receive CEU's or environmental education certification credit.
- Follow-up session will consist of a homework assignment with the option of a facility tour.
- FREE to Wake County Public School System teachers.
- Lunch will be provided!
