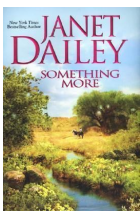
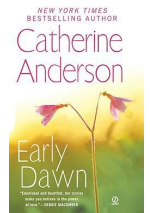




**Early Dawn by Catherine Anderson**

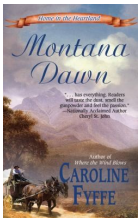
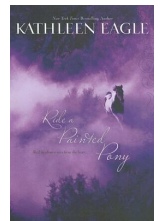


**Something More by Janet Dailey**

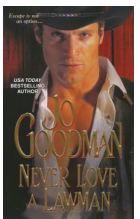
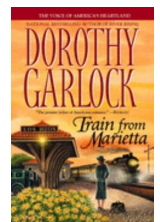


**Montana Dawn by Caroline Fyffe**

Born and raised on the Broken Circle Ranch, Eden falls for the heir to a British earldom while in London and must convince this aristocrat to try love, Texas style.



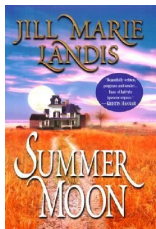
**Compromised Hearts by Hannah Howell**

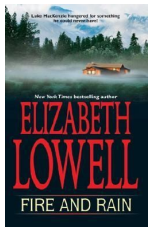
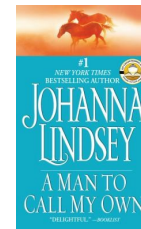


## **Summer Moon by Jill Marie Landis**

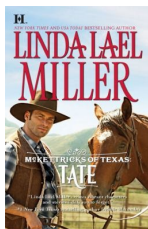
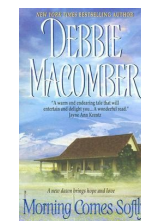


## **Fire and Rain by Elizabeth Lowell**

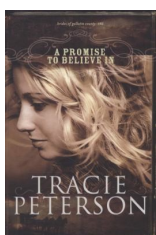
## **Prairie Moon by Maggie Osborne**

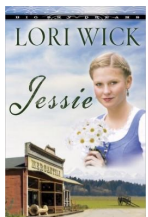
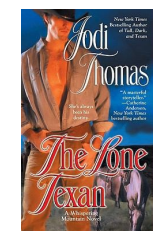


## **A Promise to Believe In by Tracie Peterson**
