Energy Conservation Block Grant Funding Affecting Wake County Website for Citizens Plans for Appropriation of Funds



Energy Conservation Block Grant

\$58 million to North Carolina localities

\$3,030,300 to Wake County Government

Raleigh - \$3,820,400

Cary - \$1,166,800

To be used for any project that reduces fuel emissions, or energy use

Specific regulations still forthcoming

State Roadways

I-440 from Wake Forest Road to Wade Ave
(\$4 million)

US 64 from US 64/264 Bypass to Nash County
(\$7.9 million)

I-540 from I-40 to US 70
(\$4 million)

I-264/64 from Zebulon to Nash County line
(\$2.5 million)

State HHS Office of Economic Opportunity Community Services Block Grant
