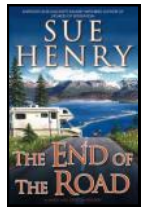
Cat in an Ultramarine Scheme by Carole Nelson Douglas

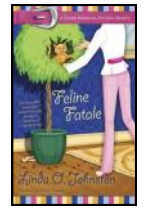
Murder Past Due by Miranda James

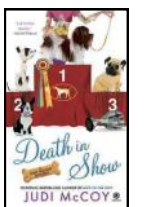


When the Cat's Away by Gilbert Morris
