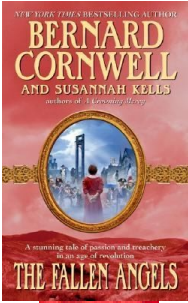


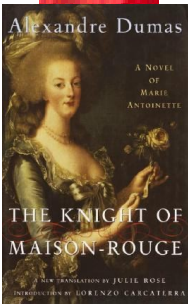

Enjoy these fictional tales set during the French Revolution.



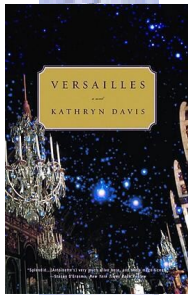
[THE FALLEN ANGELS](#) by Bernard Cornwell and Susannah Kells

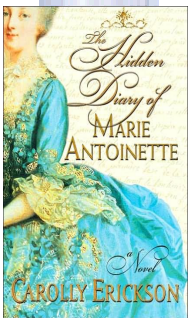
[THE KNIGHT OF MAISON ROUGE](#) by Alexandre Dumas

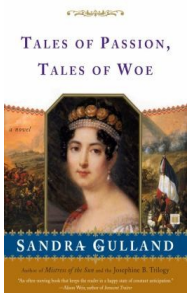
[VERSAILLES](#) by Kathryn Davis

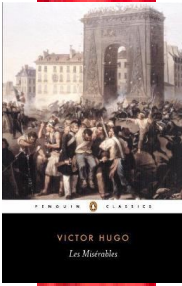
[TALES OF PASSION, TALES OF WOE](#) by Sandra Gulland

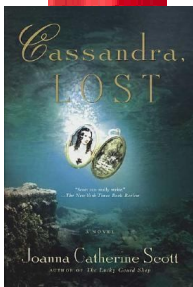

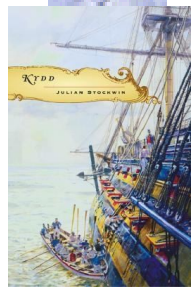
[LES MISÉRABLES](#) by Victor Hugo

Trying to forget his past and live an honest life, escaped convict Jean Valjean risks his freedom to take care of a motherless young girl during a period of political unrest in Paris.



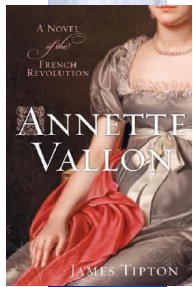
[CASSANDRA, LOST](#) by Joanna Catherine Scott

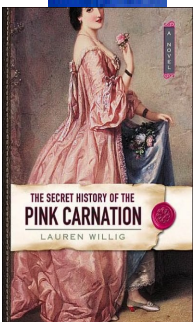
[KYDD](#) by Julian Stockwin
