[The Eleventh Commandment](#) by Jeffrey Archer

Connor Fitzgerald has led a double life for the last 28 years as the CIA's most deadly assassin. Just days before his retirement from the CIA, he comes across an enemy he can't handle--his own boss--Helen Dexter, the director of the CIA.

[Absolute Power](#) by David Baldacci

An unlikely witness threatens a high-level government cover-up--orchestrated by the Secret Service and a ruthlessly loyal White House chief-of-staff--of a brutal murder involving the president and his mistress. Also try [Last Man Standing](#) and [Split Second](#).

[Dangerous Ground](#) by Larry Bond

Assigned a final mission aboard a dilapidated submarine, tyrannical commander Lowell Hardy alienates his crew by conducting an illegal search through Russian coastal waters, where they survey hidden nuclear fuel containers. [Cold Choices](#) is the sequel; also try the [Larry Bond's First Team](#) novels.

[The American](#) by Andrew Britton

Renegade CIA agent Ryan Kealey, along with British-born agent Naomi Kharmai, must track former U.S. soldier Jason March, a brilliant assassin who has aligned himself with a Middle East terror network bent on the annihilation of the United States. [The Assassin](#) is next in the series.

[Flight of the Old Dog](#) by Dale Brown

Fitted with state-of-the-art weaponry, a lone B-52 navigated by Pat McLanahan attempts to survive waves of Soviet surface-to-air missiles and MIG fighters and drop a single bomb on a Star Wars-type laser installation in Siberia. The McLanahan series continues with [Day of the Cheetah](#) and [Sky Masters](#).

[Seas of Crisis](#) by Joe Buff

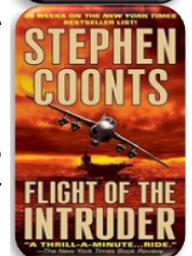
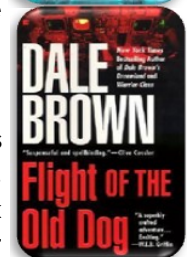
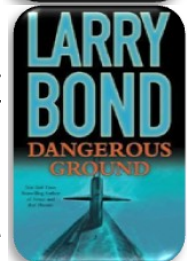
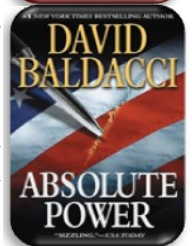
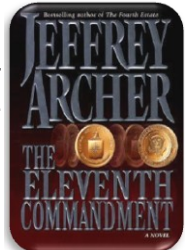

Britain is blockaded and only America remains to fight on and in the last battlefield, the oceans of the world. Cmdr. Jeffery Fuller captains the USS Challenger, the most powerful nuclear-powered fast-attack submarine in America's arsenal. [Flight of the Intruder](#) by Stephen Coonts

This first novel by an ex-Naval aviator features Lt. Jake "Cool Hand" Grafton and his fellow pilots, who are stationed on the aircraft carrier Shiloh off the South Vietnamese coast in 1973. Grafton's anger at the rarely seen enemy and bitterness towards the "precious asses" in Washington grow until they explode in a daring and unauthorized raid on the National Assembly Building in Hanoi. The Jake Grafton novels continue with [Final Flight](#) and [The Minotaur](#).

[Pandora's Legion](#) by Harold Coyle

When Al-Qaida sends men and women infected with the lethal Marburg virus into some of the world's major cities, a team from Strategic Solutions Inc. launches a desperate race to stop the plague carriers before they can reach the United States. Also try [Prometheus's Child](#) and [Vulcan's Fire](#).



[Transfer of Power](#) by Vince Flynn

When a gang of terrorists seizes control of the White House, taking hostages, leaving many dead, and driving the president to a secret bunker, it is up to the CIA's top counterterrorism specialist, Mitch Rapp, to stop the insurrection. The next Mitch Rapp novel is [The Third Option](#).

[The First 48](#) by Tim Green

When his daughter, an investigative reporter for the Washington Post, vanishes while preparing to break a story about a powerful senator, Tom Redmon heads for Washington, determined to uncover the truth and find his daughter. Also try [The Fourth Perimeter](#) and [The Fifth Angel](#).

[By Order of the President](#) by W.E.B. Griffin

When a leased Boeing 727 mysteriously vanishes after two passengers murder the pilot, Army intelligence officer Major Carlos Guillermo Castillo, a veteran of the Special Forces, is called in by the president of the United States to uncover the truth and embarks on an undercover investigation into a case with frightening implications. The next in the Presidential Agent series is [The Hostage](#).

[The Eye of the Storm](#) by Jack Higgins

Elusive master terrorist Sean Dillon reemerges during the Gulf War when Saddam Hussein hires him to assassinate Margaret Thatcher, and only Martin Brosnan can stop him. The next book in the Sean Dillon thriller series is [Thunder Point](#).

[Rogue Warrior: Red Cell](#) by Richard Marcinko

Red Cell is the second in the Rogue Warrior series, but the first novel, presented as a fictionalized account of Marcinko's adventures as a Navy SEAL. Dick Marcinko (the character) fights terrorists while slinging one liners and giving new meaning to the phrase "curse like a sailor." The international, globe-hopping action in this series will satisfy most Military Fiction buffs. [Green Team](#) is the next in the series.

[Storming Heaven](#) by Kyle Mills

Mark Beamon, a maverick FBI agent, braves a mysterious campaign of harassment against him to investigate the head of a little-known church who may have kidnapped a teenage girl. [Free Fall](#) is the next in the Mark Beamon series.

[Firewall](#) by R.J. Pineiro

After the death of his employer, artificial intelligence tycoon Mortimer Fox, ex-CIA agent Bruce Tucker races to find Fox's daughter Monica, who is in possession of a top-secret, time-sensitive code capable of launching the world's nuclear missiles. While not strictly military, the ex-CIA agent and computer technology do make this novel a good bet for Clancy fans. Also try [Havoc](#).

[The Crisis](#) by David Poyer

Assigned to improve an undisciplined patrol craft squadron in the Red Sea, Naval Commander Dan Lenson and his Tactical Analysis Group find themselves on a humanitarian mission in famine-stricken northern Africa, where a young jihadist coordinates a violent insurgency. This novel in the Tales of the Modern Navy series was published in 2009, [The Weapon](#) precedes this book.

[Nimitz Class](#) by Patrick Robinson

The Nimitz Class nuclear aircraft carrier USS Thomas Jefferson is secretly attacked and destroyed. At first, the loss is deemed an accident, but Lt. Commander Bill Baldrige convinces the President that the ship was attacked. The investigation takes him from Britain's top-flight submarine school to the depths of the Bosphorus in pursuit of a rogue Iraqi sub captain and his commandeered Russian submarine. Also try Robinson's other Navy novels, including [H.M.S. Unseen](#).

[The Lions of Lucerne](#) by Brad Thor

When a group of Secret Service agents is massacred in Utah and the president of the United States is abducted, surviving agent Scot Harvath vows to avenge his murdered colleagues and find the kidnappers. [Path of the Assassin](#) is next in the series.

[Assured Response](#) by Joe Weber

Confronted by deadly terrorists who will stop at nothing in their quest to annihilate the United States, President Cord Macklin sends two top-secret operatives on a mission to stop a nuclear holocaust. Also try
