Jack Ryan and John Clark Novels by Tom Clancy

[Without Remorse](#) (first in series): While technically CIA-operative books, these titles also contain elements of the FBI. Follow Irish-American Jack Ryan's rise from Marine to CIA counter-terrorism agent during the Cold War and ultimately, the presidency of the United States, all while embroiled in international politics and fighting for national security with the aid of special operative John Clark.

FBI Suspense Thriller Series by Catherine Coulter

[The Cove](#) (first in series): Sally Brainerd, daughter of the murdered Amory St. John, flees Washington, D.C., to seek sanctuary in the quaint little town called The Cove, pursued by undercover FBI agent James Quinlan, who believes that Sally holds the key to solving her father's murder.

John Corey Novels by Nelson DeMille

[Plum Island](#) (first in series): When Tom and Judy Gordon are found murdered in their Long Island home, NYPD detective John Corey uncovers a chilling link between the couple's deaths and the theft and illegal sale of genetically altered viruses, and races against time to stop the possible release of a deadly plague. (Note: Corey works for the FBI in later books in series).

Broken Wing Thrillers by John E. Douglas

[Broken Wings](#) (first of two titles): When his former boss, the director of the FBI, turns up dead, former profiler John Chase comes out of retirement to investigate and finds himself facing off against a ruthless and clever opponent.

FBI Profiler Series (Pierce Quincy) by Lisa Gardner

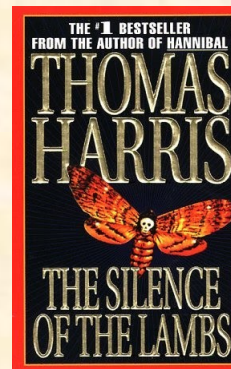
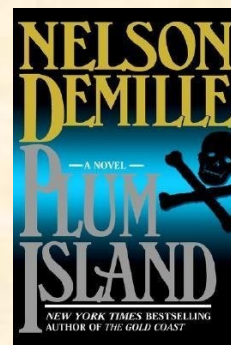
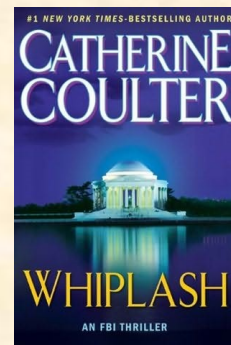
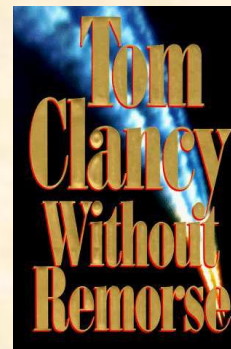
[The Perfect Husband](#) (first in series): Presents the suspenseful, nerve-shattering story of a woman who puts her husband behind bars for the murders of ten women, only to become his intended next target when he escapes, and is forced to learn to fight back to save her own life.

Hannibal Lecter Novels by Thomas Harris

The best-known title of this series [Silence of the Lambs](#) is actually the third title in series. FBI Academy trainee Clarice Starling hopes that Dr. Hannibal Lecter, a criminally insane psychiatrist imprisoned in a Boston hospital, can lead her to the serial killer known only as Buffalo Bill.

The "Bishop" Special Crimes Unit Novels by Kay Hooper

[Stealing Shadows](#) (first in series): While recovering from her last traumatic attempt to help the police catch a killer, psychic Cassie Neill's mind is filled with the thoughts of a psychopath, but as she struggles to place a name or face to the evil thoughts, she discovers that he is stalking her.

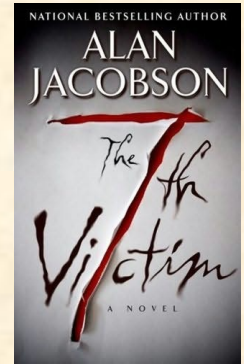

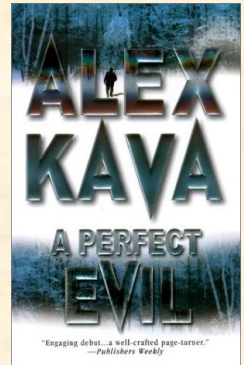
Karen Vail Mysteries by Alan Jacobson

[The 7th Victim](#) (first in series): As FBI Profiling Unit's Special Agent Karen Vail works on the case of the Dead Eyes Killer, his seventh victim unlocks dangerous secrets that threaten both her career and life.



Maggie O'Dell Novels by Alex Kava

[A Perfect Evil](#) (first in series): Still reeling from effects of her last case, FBI profiler Maggie O'Dell arrives in Platte City, Nebraska determined to help catch a potential copycat kidnapper who murders young boys.

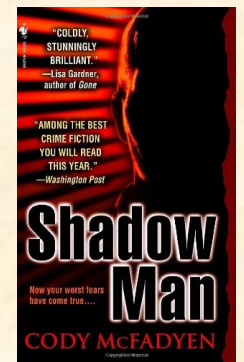


Novels of the FBI by Paul Lindsay

[Witness to the Truth](#) (first in series): Mike Devlin, a veteran of the FBI's Detroit field office, recruits a squad of fellow FBI mavericks to find a Mafia mole, solve an ominous kidnapping, and circumvent his bureaucracy-minded superiors.

Smokey Barrett Thrillers by Cody McFayden

[Shadow Man](#) (first in series): Once the FBI's hottest serial killer hunter, Smoky Barrett is left scarred in body and mind following a brutal encounter with a psychotic killer, and is on the verge of suicide when she is confronted by an all new evil called the Shadow Man.



Mark Beamon Thrillers by Kyle Mills

[Rising Phoenix](#) (first in series): When a zealous TV evangelist and his security aide, a former drug enforcement agent, conspire to poison the nation's illegal drug supply out of moral fervor, two very different FBI agents attempt to head off an epidemic of death.

Alex Cross Mysteries by James Patterson

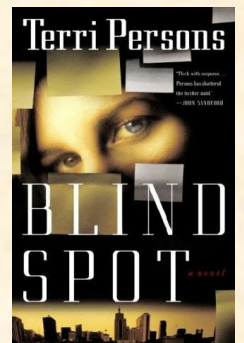
[Along Came a Spider](#) (first in series) : Serial murder; bank robbery; kidnapping. Violent criminals perpetrating grisly crimes. All investigated by Washington, D.C. police detective/psychologist Alex Cross (who at times in the series also works for the FBI). Told from the points of view of both Cross and the killer, these roller-coaster cases have lots of twists. Other stand-alone titles, like *Honeymoon*, by this author.

Pendergast Novels by Douglas Preston & Lincoln Child

[Relic](#) (first in series): Investigating a series of savage murders that disrupt a massive new exhibition at the New York Museum of Natural History, graduate student Margo Green finds a clue in a failed Amazonian expedition.

Berndette St. Clair Series by Terri Persons

[Blind Spot](#) (first in series): Just reassigned to the FBI office in St. Paul, agent Bernadette Saint Clare is called upon to use her unique if erratic talent for using items found at a crime scene to see through a killer's eyes, but her efforts are undermined by the agent in charge, Tony Garcia.



Puller Monk Novels by Gene Riehl

[Quantico Rules](#) (first in series): While investigating the background of Judge Brenda Thompson, the first African American woman to be nominated to the Supreme Court, FBI agents Puller Monk and Lisa Sands follow a trail of corruption pointing to the bureau's top levels.

Reigns Family Trilogy by Teri Woods

[Deadly Reigns](#) (first in trilogy): FBI agent Grace Moore goes undercover to bring down the deadly Reigns family, but her plan may be in jeopardy when she finds herself falling for Damian Reigns.
