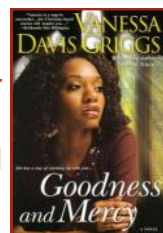
FANNIN' THE FLAMES by PARRY BROWN (Adult Fiction)

GOODNESS AND MERCY by VANESSA DAVIS GRIGGS

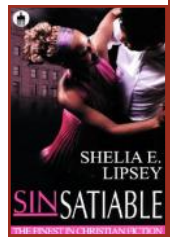

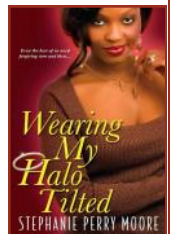
YESTERDAY'S PROMISE by VANESSA MILLER

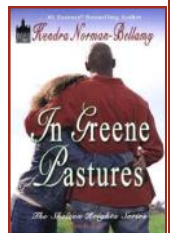
WEARING MY HALO TILTED by STEPHANIE PERRY MOORE

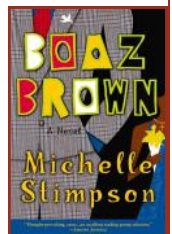


IN GREENE PASTURES by KENDRA NORMAN-BELLAMY

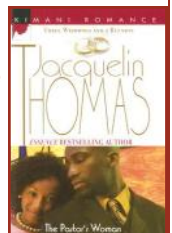
BOAZ BROWN by MICHELLE STIMPSON
