

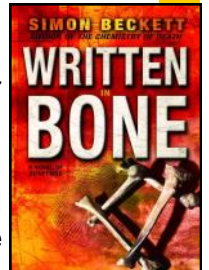


On the Edge Of Your Seat

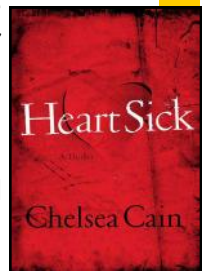


The Venetian Betrayal by Steve Berry

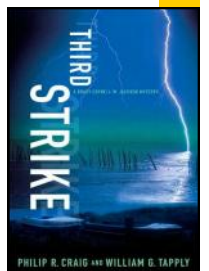


Missing Witness by Gordon Campbell

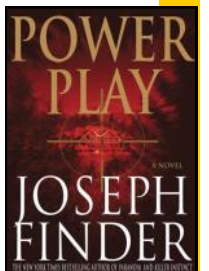


Requiem for an Assassin by Barry Eisler

Blackmailed by a rogue CIA operative to carry out three assassinations or lose his best friend, reluctant killer-for-hire John Rain struggles with moral dilemmas as well as his growing certainty that the operative is hiding a more sinister agenda.

Power Play by Joseph Finder

Cut off from the outside world at a remote resort for a corporate retreat, Jake Landry, a junior executive at the Hammond Aerospace Corporation, is forced to draw on the skills of his secret past when the executives are taken hostage.



Dead Heat by Dick Francis (Mystery)

With his rising culinary career threatened by an episode of food poisoning at a private affair that he had catered, Max Moreton caters an exclusive luncheon at the Two Thousand Guineas horse race, a party devastated by a bomb blast that kills many of the guests.

The Abduction by Mark Gimenez

The kidnapping of his ten-year-old granddaughter Gracie, brings Ben Brice, a veteran drowning his memories of Vietnam with alcohol, back from the New Mexico wilderness to help save her, but dark family secrets could threaten the child's survival.

The Anatomy of Deception by Lawrence Goldstone

Nineteenth-century Philadelphia physician Ephraim Carroll draws on the new techniques of forensic medicine to investigate the brutal murder of a beautiful young woman and the horror that led to her death.



Night Work by Steve Hamilton (Mystery)

New York juvenile probation officer Joe Trumbull matches wits with a deadly unknown adversary responsible for the deaths of his fiancée and other women with whom he has been involved, as he takes on an enemy intent on destroying him.

Down River by John Hart

Five years after fleeing to New York in the wake of a murder acquittal, Adam Chase returns to North Carolina, only to find himself trapped in the middle of a new murder case as people around him begin to die and he is once again a suspect.

The Sanctuary by Raymond Khoury

More than 250 years after a pretender marquis escapes the palazzo of his vengeful prince, an American Army unit discovers a secret lab in Baghdad where victims have been subjected to torturous experiments, a finding that places two women on the trail of an ancient mystery.

Acts of Nature by Jonathon King

On a technology-free vacation in an isolated region of the Florida Everglades, P.I. Max Freeman and detective Sherry Richards are caught in the path of a violent hurricane that tests their survival skills and pits them against murderous looters.

Darkness Falls by Kyle Mills

Living reclusively in the Arizona desert since the death of his girlfriend, Erin Neal suddenly finds himself back on the international stage when a number of important Saudi oil resources are threatened by a mysterious new bacteria with a voracious appetite for oil.

The Betrayal Game by David L. Robbins

In 1961, Professor Mikhal Lammeck, a specialist in the history and weaponry of assassins, becomes caught in the middle of a series of failed assassination attempts as the CIA, Cubans in Miami, the American mob, and the KGB all target Fidel Castro.

The Reincarnationist by M.J. Rose

After surviving a bombing in Rome, photojournalist Josh Ryder is plagued by strange memories from an ancient time that instruct him to save a woman named Sabina and, desperate for answers, he consults an expert on past life experiences.

At the City's Edge by Marcus Sakey

When his brother is murdered, Jason Palmer finds himself protecting his eight-year-old nephew from two killers with a mysterious agenda, while his Chicago South Side neighborhood erupts in a bloodbath of gang warfare and high-level political corruption.

Ice Trap by Kitty Sewell

Learning that he had fathered twins in icy remote Canada fifteen years earlier, a Welsh surgeon finds his career and marriage rapidly unraveling in the face of changes that compel him to confront past demons.

Flawless by Joshua Spanogle

Leaving his job at the Centers for Disease Control to build a new life in San Francisco, Dr. Nathaniel McCormick is confronted by a vicious murder that takes him from the high-tech labs of the cosmetic industry into a dangerous, high-stakes black market.

Malice by Robert K. Tanenbaum

Barely escaping an assassination attempt, New York district attorney Butch Karp works to uncover a criminal empire that hires terrorists to further their interests and has lately targeted schoolchildren.

Dead Time by Stephen White

Psychologist Alan Gregory struggles to adapt to a shaky marriage and new fatherhood, a situation that is complicated by his ex-wife's entreaty to help her find her pregnant surrogate.
