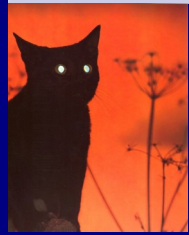

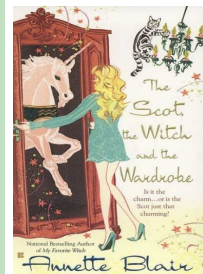


Chick Lit

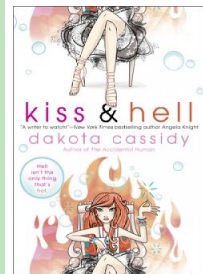


The Night I Got Lucky by Laura Caldwell

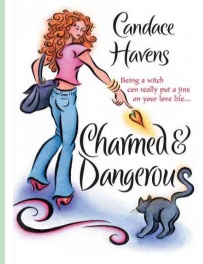
Kiss & Hell by Dakota Cassidy

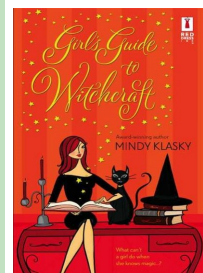
Tall, Dark and Dead by Tate Hallaway

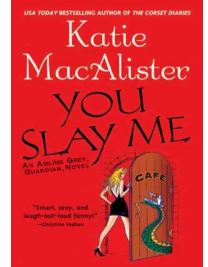

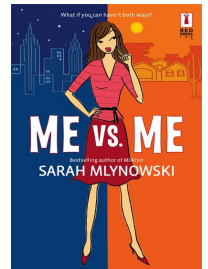
You Slay Me by Katie MacAlister

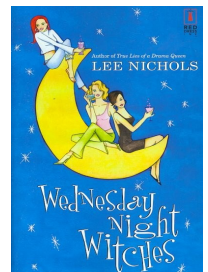
Bit the Jackpot by Erin McCarthy

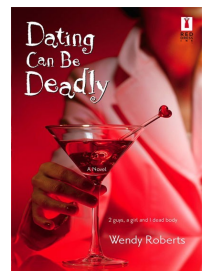


Wednesday Night Witches by Lee Nichols

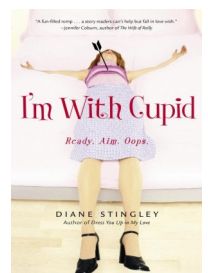
Dating Can Be Deadly by Wendy Roberts

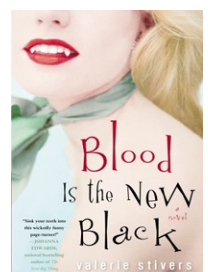
Fanged and Fabulous by Michelle Rowen
