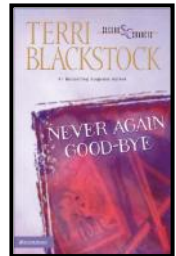

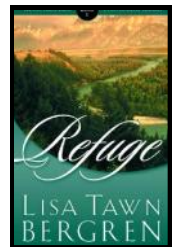
NEVER AGAIN GOODBYE –TERRI BLACKSTOCK

REFUGE – LISA TAWN BERGREN

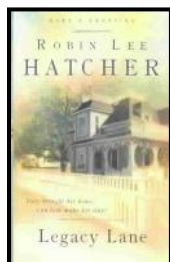

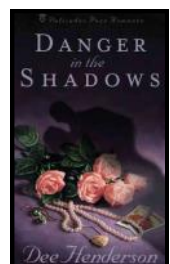
LEGACY LANE – ROBIN LEE HATCHER

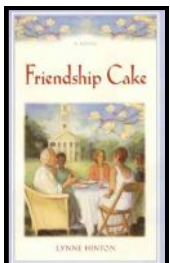
RUSH OF WINGS – KRISTEN HEITZMANN

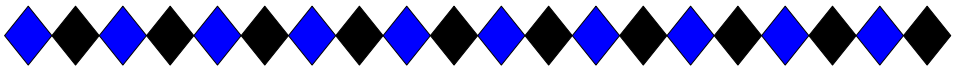
ANGER IN THE SHADOWS – DEE HENDERSON

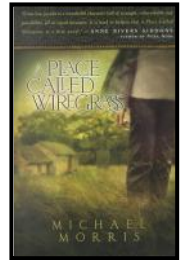
DOESN'T SHE LOOK NATURAL – ANGELA ELWELL HUNT

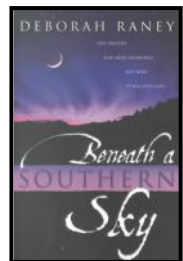
SUMMER OF THE MIDNIGHT SUN – TRACIE PETERSON

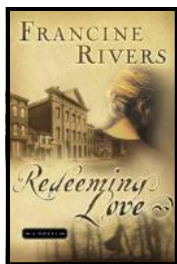


BENEATH A SOUTHERN SKY – DEBORAH RANEY

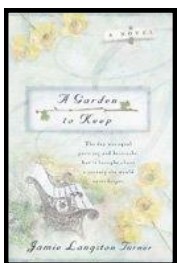

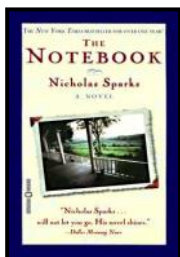
REDEEMING LOVE – FRANCINE RIVERS
