[The Heartbreak Pill](#) by Anjanette Delgado

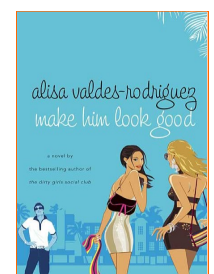
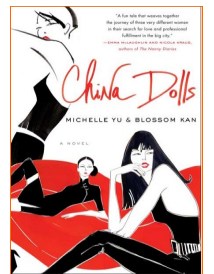
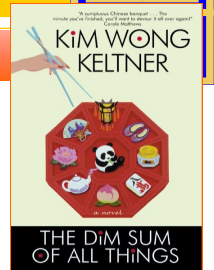
