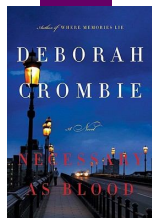
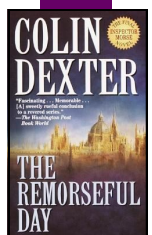

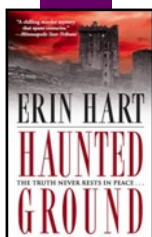
The Kincaid & James series by **Deborah Crombie**

Death at La Fenice

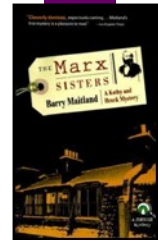

The Marx Sisters

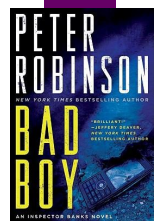

From Doon with Death

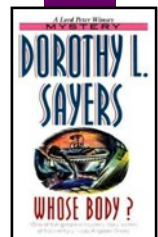
