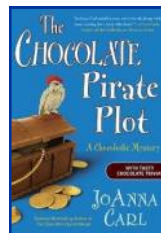
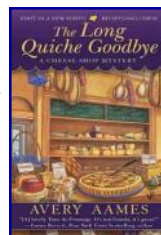

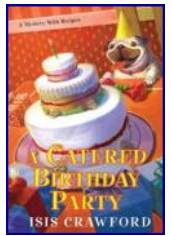
[Cook the Books](#) by Jessica Conant-Park

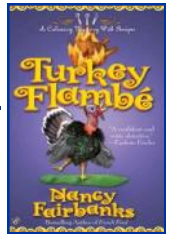
A Catered Birthday Party by Isis Crawford

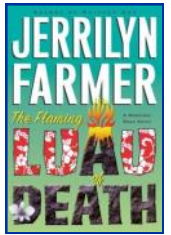
Fatally Flaky by Diane Mott Davidson

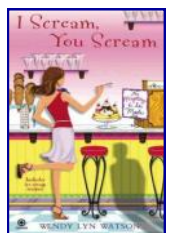
The Da Vinci Cook by Joanne Pence
