

Classification Title: Identification Technician

FLSA Status: Non-Exempt

BRIEF DESCRIPTION: Obtains and establishes arrest information, fingerprints suspects, and collects other data and information. Enters appropriate information into databases. Verifies identification of arrestees. Administers chemical breath tests for alcohol and disseminates criminal information to other law enforcement and authorized agencies.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

#	Code	Essential Functions
1	S	Accesses a variety of confidential data files by entering personal arrestee information to obtain criminal history. Interprets relevant information and disseminates to authorized agencies.
2	L	Determines if arrestee is a repeat offender by comparing right thumbprints in the system for verification. Obtains other fingerprints for further comparison and enters information into system.
3	L	Obtains fingerprints using automated and manual techniques. Disseminates disposition sheets for court purposes.
4	S	Administers chemical breath tests to determine alcohol concentration. Responds to hospitals to read chemical test rights and observe blood draws of those suspected of DWI. Maintains detailed reports of all tests administered.
5	S	Retrieves all documents and reports for courtroom testimony. Testifies as an expert witness with regard to chemical breath testing.
