- Take a hike on [Blue Jay's Azalea Loop interpretive trail](#) (begins just inside the park gate—park at the Education Center). There are 18 numbered posts with cool things to learn—pick up an interpretive guide at the beginning of the trail.
 - Visit our [hands-on exhibits](#) in the Blue Jay Center for Environmental Education (near the flagpole) and get information about other FUN indoor and outdoor activities you can do in the park! The BJ Center is open 8am-5pm daily.
