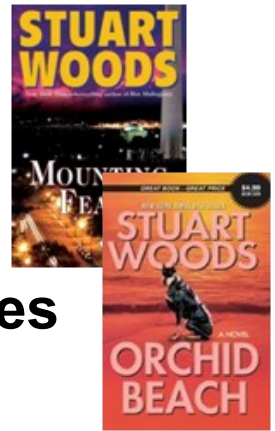


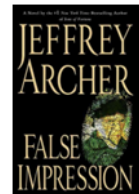

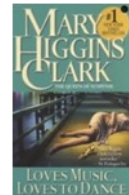


Blood of Angels by Reed Arvin

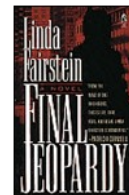


The Lost Bird by Margaret Coel

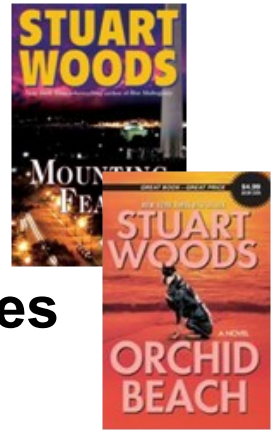
Final Jeopardy by Linda Fairstein

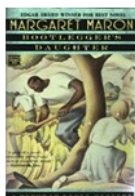
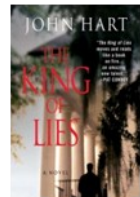


Trust Fund by Stephen Frey

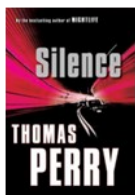


Bootlegger's Daughter by Margaret Maron
