

Classification Title: Senior Equipment Operator

FLSA Status: Non-Exempt

BRIEF DESCRIPTION: Provides specialized, technical alteration, repair, replacement and maintenance to County facilities and sites, landscaping, internal specialized equipment, or hard surfaces. Operates a variety of large and small equipment and trailers used in the general repair and maintenance of streets, landscaping and emergency response.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

This information is intended to be descriptive of the key responsibilities of the position. The following examples do not identify all duties performed by any single incumbent.

#	Code	Essential Functions
1	V	Leads or supervises workers or teams and completes work orders for scheduled tasks and special projects which could include moves, landscaping, turf maintenance, equipment or warehouse maintenance, and repair of hard surfaces.
2	V	Performs complex skilled work repairing, replacing or maintaining equipment-supplying services to the County or its departments. Assists in training staff on equipment used.
3	S	Reviews work orders for services, moves or maintenance, meets with supervisors or team to discuss pending work or repairs and requests materials or supplies to accomplish tasks.
4	S	Inspects completed work or tasks. Coordinates operations with contractors, vendors, or other departments or work units.
5	V	Responds to emergency and inclement weather requests for items such as snow and debris removal. Supervises contractors responsible for additional cleanup.
