- A. **“Educate Our Women”** (Komen Foundation Grantee) (919) 431-4032 - 25 yrs. plus (some exceptions on a case by case basis), African American & Latina, Wake County Resident, & Uninsured.
- B. **“Filling the Economic and Cultural Gap for Young Women”** (Planned Parenthood) (919) 833-7526 - less than 40 yrs. but not exclusionary, Uninsured & Underinsured. For clients who present to their clinic.
- C. **“Healthy Women, Healthy Wake”** (919) 431-4032 or (919) 784-6247 - 30 yrs. plus, African American & Latina; but not exclusionary, Wake County Resident, Uninsured & Underinsured
- D. **Rex Mammography Certificate Program** (919) 784-6186 – At least 35 yrs. old, Income verification required
- E. **Pretty in Pink Foundation** (919) 532-0532 – Treatment only of Women with Breast Cancer, Uninsured & Underinsured
- F. **ENCOREplus** (YWCA) (919) 863-9064 -ages 40 & up, Income guidelines, serving Wake Johnston, and Franklin Counties
- G. **Breast & Cervical Cancer Control Program (BCCCP)** (919) 212-9310 (Wake County) or 1-800-662-7030 - (National) Ages 40-64 yrs., Uninsured & Underinsured with income verification. NOTE: The patient must have been enrolled & screened/diagnosed through the BCCCP program in order to be eligible for BCCCP Medicaid.
- H. **Project Access** – A Wake County Medical Society Program that partners with existing low income clinics, Primary Care Providers and all hospitals to provide healthcare to the low income, uninsured residents of Wake County. Income verification required. NOTE: Patients cannot self refer to the Project Access office for services. They must be screened by one of the Project Access enrollee sites. Note: Duke University Breast MRI screening for Uninsured and Underinsured Women provides free breast MRI's to women who are at the highest risk for developing breast cancer. (919) 668-3051 - ext. 2454
