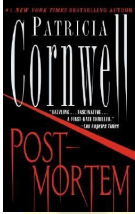


If You Like Kathy Reichs...

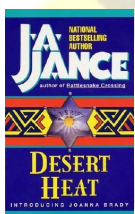


[A is for Alibi](#) by Sue Grafton

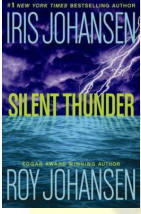


[Desert Heat](#) by J.A. Jance

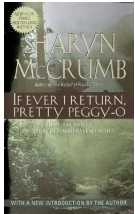


[Silent Thunder](#) by Iris Johansen

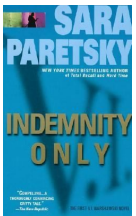


[If Ever I Return, Pretty Peggy-O](#) by Sharyn McCrumb

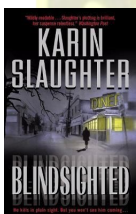


[Indemnity Only](#) by Sara Paretsky
