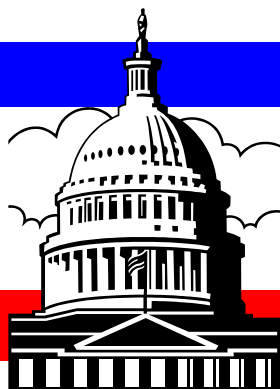

## [THE STREET LAWYER](#) BY **JOHN GRISHAM**

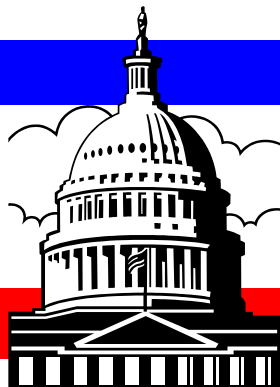
