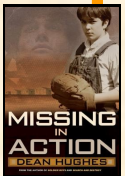
My Chocolate Year: A Novel With 12 Recipes J HERMAN

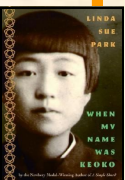


Missing in Action J HUGHES

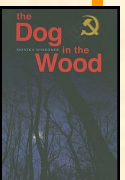


On the Wings of Heroes J PECK

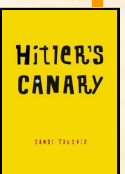


The Dog in the Wood J SCHRODER

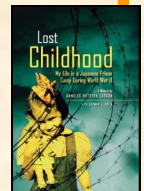

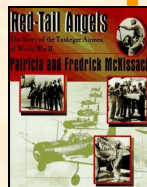

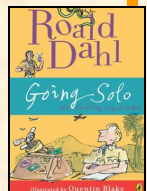
