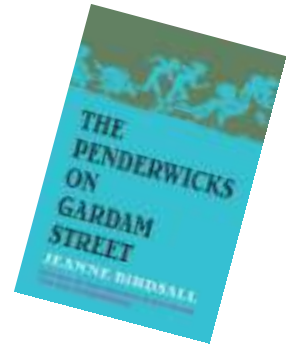


IF YOU LIKE THE PENDERWICKS...

Summer Begins

J Carey

In this first book in the Callahan Cousins series, four 12 year old girls all travel to Gull Island to spend the summer with their beloved grandmother.

Beezus and Ramona

J Cleary

Serious, sensible Beezus is worried because she doesn't always get along with her younger sister Ramona, who is always causing trouble, until Beezus finds out that her mother didn't always get along with her siblings when she was young.

Ruby Holler

J Creech

Thirteen-year-old twins Dallas and Florida have grown up in a terrible orphanage but their lives change when an eccentric but sweet older couple invites them each on an adventure, beginning in an almost magical place called Ruby Holler.

Half Magic

J Eager

Faced with a dull summer in the city, Jane, Mark, Katharine, and Martha suddenly find themselves involved in a series of extraordinary adventures after Jane discovers an ordinary looking coin that seems to grant wishes.

Ginger Pye

J Estes

The disappearance of a new puppy named Ginger and the appearance of a mysterious man in a mustard yellow hat bring excitement into the lives of the Pye children.

Olive's Ocean

J Henkes

On a summer visit to her grandmother's cottage by the ocean, twelve-year-old Martha gains perspective on her relationship with her family and her plans to be a writer.

Our Only May Amelia**J Holm**

As the only girl in a Finnish American family of seven brothers, May Amelia Jackson resents being expected to act like a lady while growing up in Washington state in 1899.

My One Hundred Adventures**J Horvath**

Twelve-year-old Jane, who lives at the beach in a run-down old house with her poet mother, her two younger brothers, and her sister, has an eventful summer full of adventures.

Betsy-Tacy**J Lovelace**

After Tacy Kelly moves into the house across the street from Betsy Ray, the two girls become inseparable friends. This is the first book in a series that follows the friends from age 5 through their high school years.

The Willoughbys**J Lowry**

The four Willoughby children set about to become "deserving orphans" after their neglectful parents embark on an around-the-world adventure, leaving them in the care of an odious nanny.

Welcome to Camden Falls**J Martin**

Sisters Flora and Ruby must adjust to a new life and make new friends in a small town when they move in with their grandmother.

Saffy's Angel**J McKay**

After learning that she was adopted, thirteen-year-old Saffron's relationship with her eccentric, artistic family changes, until they help her go back to Italy where she was born to find a special memento of her past.

Anne of Green Gables**J Montgomery**

Anne, an eleven-year-old orphan, is sent by mistake to live with a lonely, middle-aged brother and sister on a Prince Edward Island farm and proceeds to make an indelible impression on everyone around her.

The Story of the Treasure Seekers**J Nesbit**

Relates the curious escapades of the six Bastable children who attempt to restore the family fortunes by searching for treasure, starting a newspaper, and becoming detectives.

Five Little Peppers and How They Grew**J Sidney**

In New England in the late nineteenth-century, a fatherless family, happy in spite of its impoverished condition, is befriended by a very rich gentleman and his young son.

All of a Kind Family**J Taylor**

Ella, Henny, Sarah, Charlotte, and Gertie are high spirited sisters living in New York City in the years just before World War I. This book is the first in a series that follows their adventures growing up on the Lower East Side.
