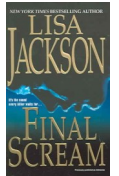
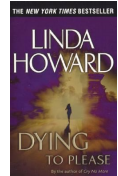
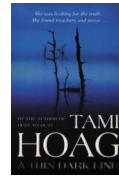
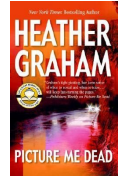
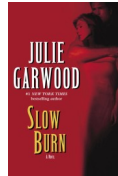
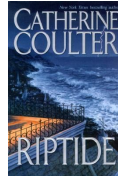




Love is Dangerous

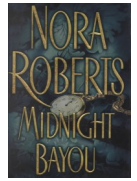
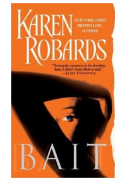
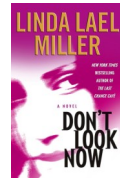
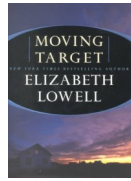
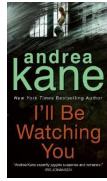
Final Scream by Lisa Jackson
