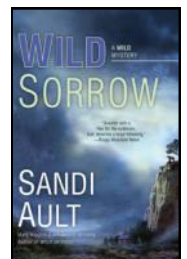


# Native American Mysteries



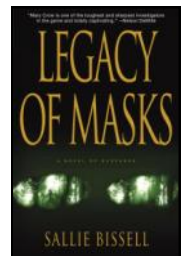
## **Wild Sorrow** by Sandi Ault

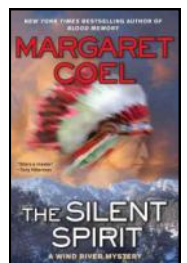
## **Legacy of Masks** by Sallie Bissell

## **The Widow's Revenge** by James Doss

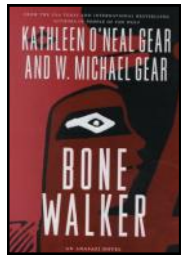

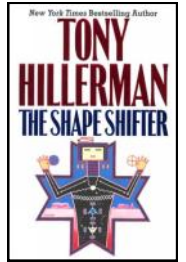
**Effigies** by Mary Anna Evans

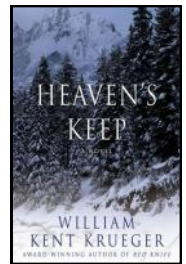
**Bone Walker** by W. Michael and Kathleen Gear

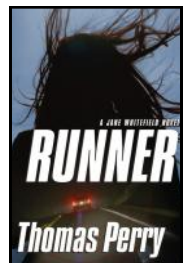
**The Shape Shifter** by Tony Hillerman

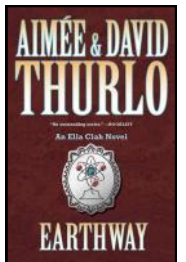
**Heaven's Keep** by William Kent Krueger

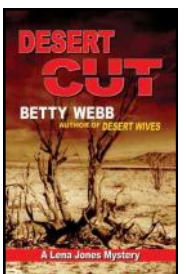
**Runner** by Thomas Perry
