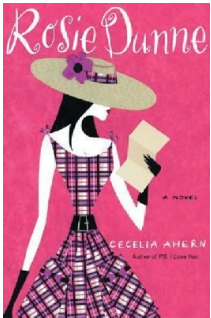

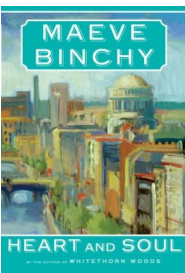
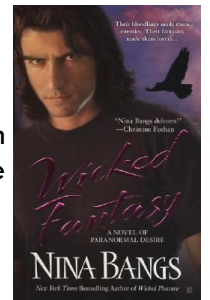


[Rosie Dunne](#) BY Ceelia Ahern

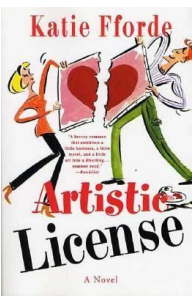
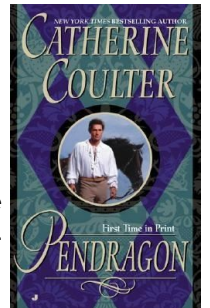


[Heart and Soul](#) BY Maeve Binchy

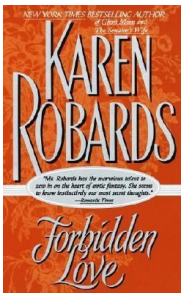


[The Brightest Star in the Sky](#) BY Marian Keyes

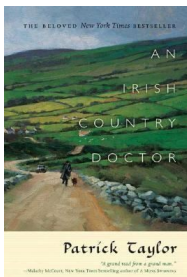
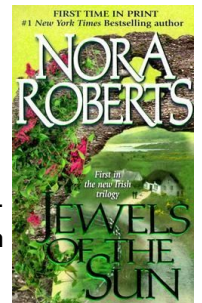


[Forbidden Love](#) BY Karen Robards
