

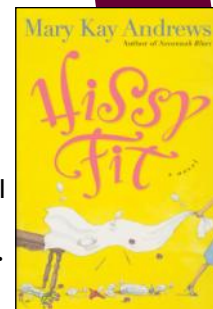


CHICKS IN CHARGE – LADIES AT LARGE

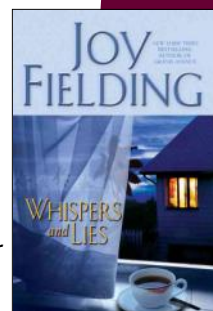


Family Tree by Barbara Delinsky

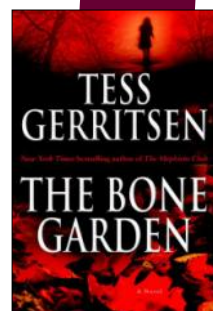


Pawley's Island by Dorothea Benton Frank

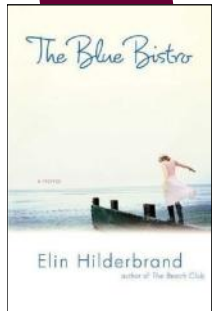
Summer Island by Kristen Hannah

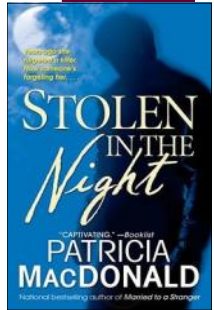


On the Run by Iris Johansen

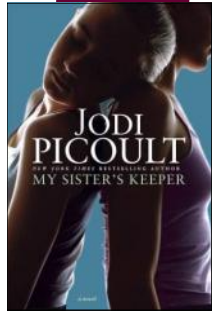


Secret Society Girl: an Ivy League Novel by Diane Peterfreund

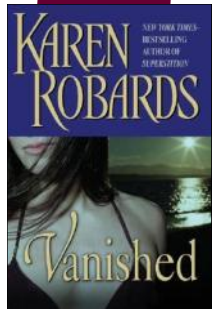


The Edge of Winter by Luanne Rice

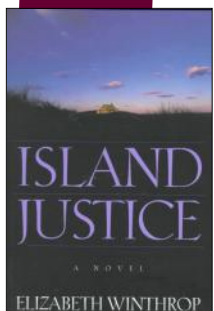


Killer Smile by Lisa Scottoline

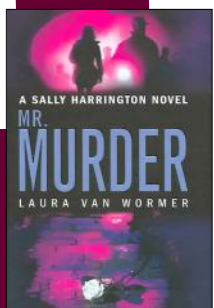
Island Justice by Elizabeth Winthrop
