

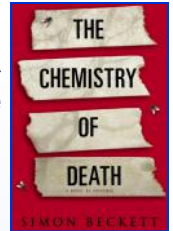

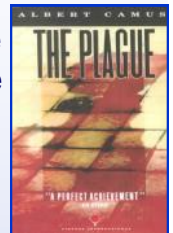
Chemistry of Death by Simon Beckett

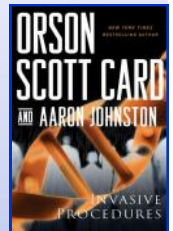
The Venetian Betrayal by Steve Berry

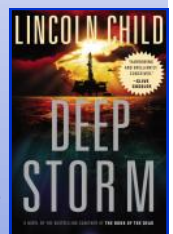
The Plague by Albert Camus

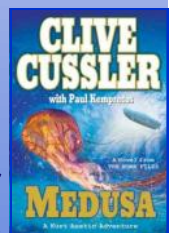
Invasive Procedures by Orson Scott Card (Science Fiction)

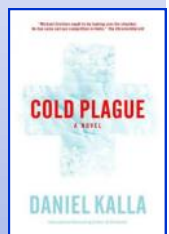
The Trudeau Vector by Juris Jurjevics

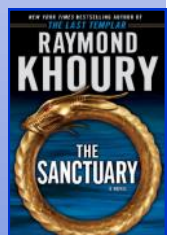
Cold Plague by Daniel Kalla

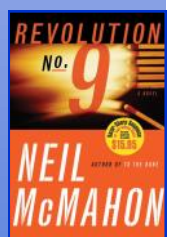
The Sanctuary by Raymond Khoury

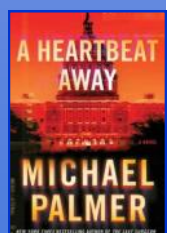
Revolution No. 9 by Neil McMahon
