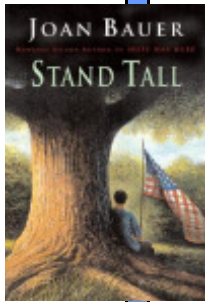


Breaking Up is Hard to Do



Stand Tall

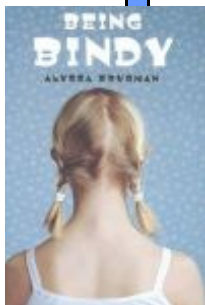
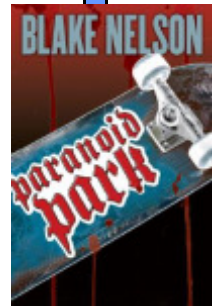
YA Bauer

Being Bindy

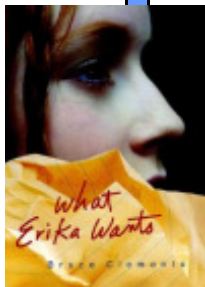
YA Brugman

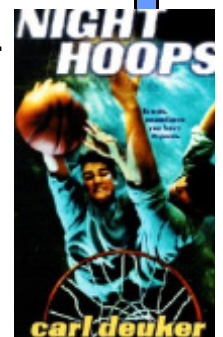

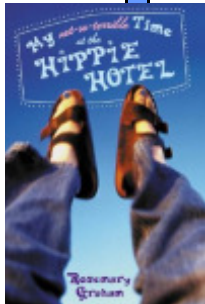
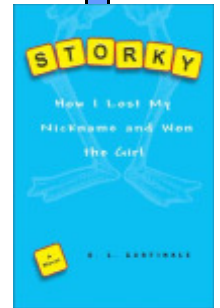
Mixed-up Doubles

Hard Love

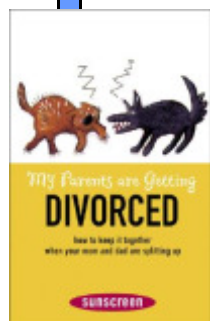
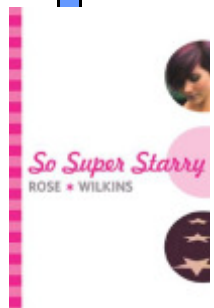
YA Wittlinger
