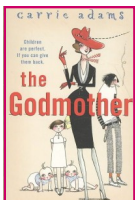




Totally Chick Lit!

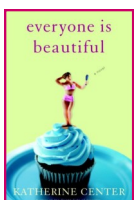


Hedge Fund Wives by Tatiana Boncompagni

The Accidental Family by Rowan Coleman

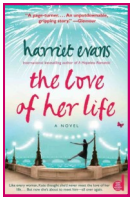
Sophie Mills moves to the country to be with her late best friend's ex-husband and his two daughters, but when he proposes, Sophie must question whether she and he are a perfect match.

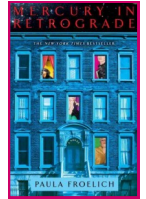


The Love of Her Life by Harriet Evans

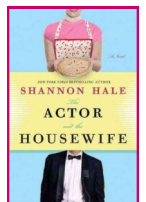


The Brightest Star in the Sky by Marian Keyes

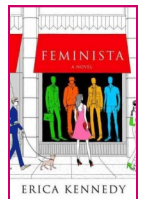


Hope in a Jar by Beth Harbison

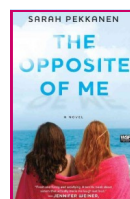
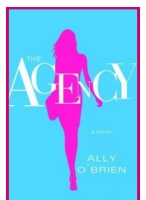


Perfect Fifths by Megan McCafferty
