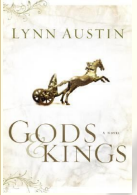

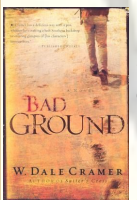
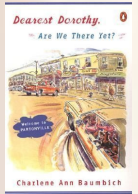


## ***Gods & Kings* by Lynn Austin**

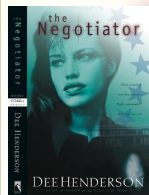


## ***Firstborn* by Robin Lee Hatcher**

## ***Secrets* by Kristen Heitzmann**

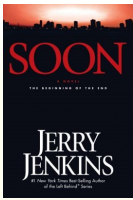

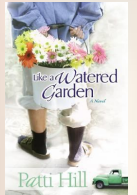


**Soon: *The Beginning Of The End* by Jerry Jenkins**

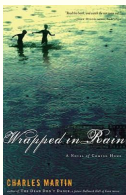
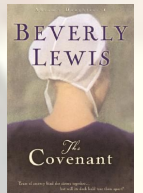


***Gideon's Gift* by Karen Kingsbury**

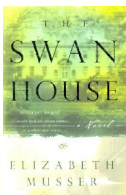


***Wrapped in Rain* by Charles Martin**

***At The Scent Of Water* by Linda Nichols**

***Swan House* by Elizabeth Musser**
