This fact sheet was created to help families locate affordable, quality and educational track-out, after/before and summer child care programs for school age children.

Wake County Public School System

WCPSS before and after-school programs provide a safe, stimulating environment for students whose family situations require student supervision before and/or after the school day. Beginning in the 2010-11 school year, students must be five years old on or before August 31 of the current school to enroll in the program. Most before-school programs begin at 7a.m. Upon request a listing of before school and after school facilities will be provided. Some of the WCPSS schools provide third party vendors who may offer care off-site locations. Contact the school directly for information about programs offered by outside agencies.

*The fee is based on an hourly rate of \$2.25 per hour. Registration fee is \$15.00 per child.

Raleigh Parks and Recreation strives to offer high quality, low cost diverse programs for all school aged participants and families in the City of Raleigh and surrounding municipalities. Programs such as After School X-Press, Before School X-Press, Track Out X-Press, Teen, & Teacher Workday Programs focus on empowering youth.

*Program Costs range from \$580-700 per program session. Raleigh Parks and Recreation recognizes that some participants may need financial assistance to participate in the programs. Funding is limited. For more information call 919-996-4800. Families interested in Summer Camp will need to visit the website in January 2011.

There are eight Boys and Girls locations in Wake County to help youth reach their full potential as productive, caring, responsible citizens. The locations are Brentwood Club, Raleigh Boys Club, Raleigh Girls Club, Summer Day Camp, Teen Center, Wake Forest Club, Washington Elementary Club and Zebulon Club.

*The annual membership fee per member is \$7.50. Summer and program fees are \$25 per week or \$5 per day. Clubs are open each day after school from 2:30pm-8pm.
