

### IPRS (State Funded) Developmental Disabilities – Child Benefit Package

NOTE: Below is a listing of all IPRS services available to children with Developmental Disabilities. The Person-Centered Plan determines the amounts and types of services an individual could receive. The amounts listed below are the maximum for each level. Services and service levels are contingent upon availability of funding.

NOTE: In-Home Respite is available up to 12 hours/month. No authorization required. Direct access through Tammy Lynn Center after eligibility established through Wake County Local Management Entity (LME).

\*\*Level D is meant to be a short term authorization, no more that 6 months total, it is felt that if a Behavior Plan cannot be implemented in this amount of time than DT is not the appropriate service or the Plan is in need of revision or there are family circumstances that interfere with implementation of the Plan. If this is the case other services need to be researched.
