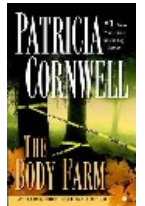

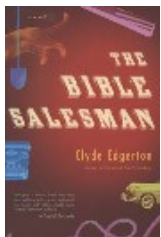
[The Body Farm](#) by Patricia Cornwell

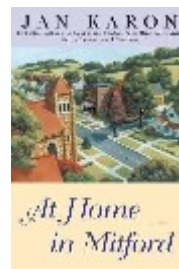
[The Life All Around Me by Ellen Foster](#) by Kaye Gibbons

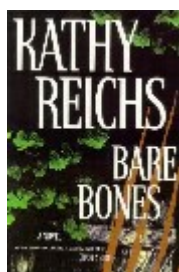
[At Home in Mitford](#) by Jan Karon

[Bare Bones](#) by Kathy Reichs

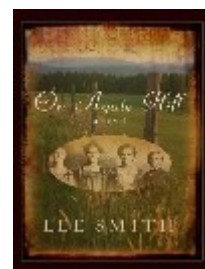
