## **The Hitchhiker's Guide To The Galaxy by Douglas Adams**

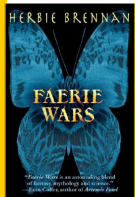
**ADAMS**

## **Faerie Wars by Herbie Brennan**

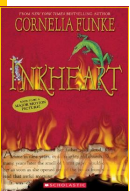
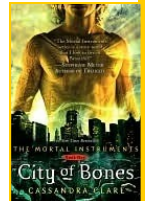
**YA BRENNAN**

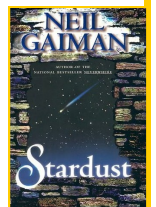
## **Inkheart by Cornelia Funke 2007 YA FUNKE**

**Wicked Lovely by Melissa Marr**

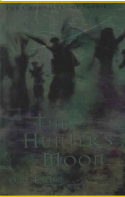
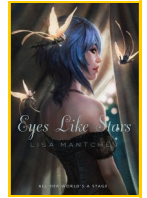
**YA MARR**

**The Hunter's Moon by O.R. Melling**

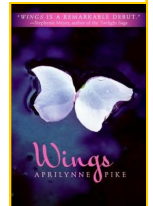
**YA MELLING**

**The Lightning Thief by Rick Riordan**

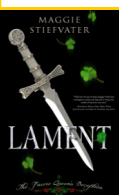
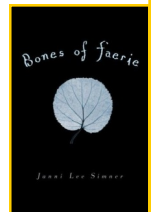
**YA RIORDAN**

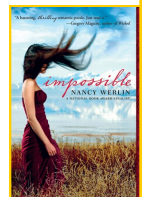
**Lament: The Faerie Queen's Deception by Maggie Stiefvater** **YA STIEFVATER**
