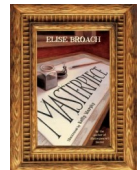

Kaleidoscope Eyes

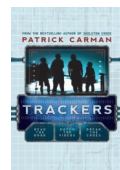

Trackers

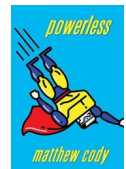

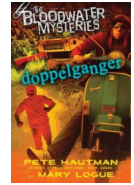

The Big Splash

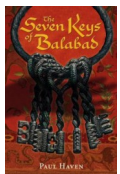
