“Respect the Can” Video Contest Rules

Eligibility:

The Wake County “Respect the Can” Video Contest is open to any Wake County Public School System middle or high school- affiliated student organization with an adult advisor. By participating in the contest, and submitting your application, entrants agree to be bound to these Contest Rules and the Terms and Conditions of the Contest. The Wake County Department of Environmental Services reserves the right (but is not obligated) to verify eligibility qualifications of any entrant or winner. Participants are ineligible if any group member is directly related to the panel of judges for the contest.

Contest Rules:

1. Videos must be created and filmed by students. Students may seek adult guidance, but the work should be that of the students. All submitted work must be original and cannot have been previously submitted in other contests.
2. Videos may not contain any copyrighted material (including music) unless written permission is obtained (if applicable, a copy of the written permission must be included with the entry).
3. Any individuals who help with the creation of the video are required to submit a signed release form, and must be listed on the Group Roster Form.
4. All entries must be postmarked by **FEBRUARY 14, 2011**. Any late or incomplete entries will not be accepted.
5. Entries must be in .wmv, .mpg, or .avi format and submitted on a DVD or flash drive. No entries will be returned.
6. All entries become property of Wake County Environmental Services and may be used at our discretion.
7. Each student group may only submit one entry for judging; submitting more than one entry will result in disqualification of all the group's entries. A school may have more than one group submitting entries.
8. All videos must be intended for youth audiences and contain content that, in the sole discretion of the judges, is suitable for persons of all ages. Any video with content deemed inappropriate will be disqualified.
9. Videos should fit the following prompt: *Create a video, up to 2 minutes in length that motivates and encourages your peers and others in the county to help reduce the amount of litter on our roads and in our community.*
10. Videos will be judged during the month of December 2010, winners will be notified shortly after.

How to Enter:

Each group must submit a copy of their video on a DVD or flash drive, along with a Group Application Form, a Group Roster Form, and each member's signed Release Form. All entries must be postmarked (no entries will be accepted in person) by November 30, 2010, to:

Prizes:

Middle school entries will be judged separate from high school entries. The top three videos from each level will be selected by the judges. Prizes for both levels are as follows:

Grand Prize: \$500

2nd place: \$250

3rd place: \$125

Honorable Mention: Anti-litter campaign t-shirts for all participating members.
