

**Classification Title: Pharmacist**

FLSA Status: Exempt

**BRIEF DESCRIPTION:** Dispenses prescription medications to clients eligible for County services and provides medication counseling as requested. Maintains inventories of all stock and supplies and billing records as required by standard or regulation.

1	L	Dispenses medication for patients eligible for and receiving services from the County. Orders special prescriptions as required. Counsels patients on medication information and interactions.
2	L	Collects money for prescriptions and balances funds. Bills insurance or Medicare/Medicaid as appropriate.
3	L	Maintains inventories of medications and orders replacements as necessary. Processes requisitions for medications and/or vaccines and reviews accounts and budget on a regular basis.
4	L	Orders prepackaged medications for distribution to patients, clinics, programs or schools. Obtains special formula medications for clients.
