*** Intensive Citizenship Class***

Do you want to study to become a U.S. citizen? Or do you just want to learn more about U.S. history, government and culture? If so, come to this class! It is an **intensive, computer-based** course, designed as preparation for the U.S. Naturalization (citizenship) Test. It will include preparation for the history and government portion of the exam and some practice for the oral interview. It is for BOTH current Wake Tech ESL students and any non-native English speaker at the intermediate level or higher, who is reading below a 9th grade level. You must also have **basic computer skills**.

This course will run on Friday evenings and Saturday mornings, for 3 hours at each session. It designed for non-native English speakers who:

- 1) cannot take our 4-night/week Citizenship Preparation class (at Millbrook HS) -- or
- 2) are already taking an ESL class and want extra U.S. civics/citizenship instruction.
