- Everyone over 6 months of age needs flu vaccine to be protected against this year's flu.
- Flu shots, nasal spray and high dose flu vaccine will all be available this year.

The cost for flu vaccine (shot and nasal spray) is \$30. High dose flu vaccine is \$60.

We accept:

- Cash
- Checks
- Medicaid
- Medicare Part B
- North Carolina Health Choice
- Insurance: Blue Cross Blue Shield, United Health Care and Cigna

There is no charge for:

- uninsured pregnant women
- children who qualify for the Vaccines for Children Program (VFC).

To qualify for vaccines under the VFC program children must be under 19 years of age AND one of the following:

- Uninsured or underinsured
- Medicaid
- American Indian or Alaskan
