REGISTRATION OPEN FOR 4-H SUMMER SLEEP-AWAY CAMP

Wake County's 4-H Youth Development program is hosting its annual **Sleep-Away Summer Camp from Sunday, June 30 through Friday, July 5, 2013, at the Eastern 4-H Environmental Education Center, 100 N. Clover Way, Columbia, N.C.** The camp is open to boys and girls between the ages of 8 and 12. The cost is \$460 and includes:

- transportation to and from the camp
- all meals
- lodging
- a \$15 camp store credit
- camp T-shirt

The last day to enroll in the camp is **Thursday, January 31, 2013**. A three-part payment arrangement is available.

The Eastern 4-H Environmental Education Center faces Bulls Bay and the Albemarle Sound and includes woodlands, meadows, forests, wetlands, creeks and rivers. Highly trained 4-H professionals, recent college graduates and students staff the camp program, providing 24-hour supervision.
