WAKE FOREST LIBRARY TO REOPEN WITH FRIENDS' CELEBRATION

The **Wake Forest Community Library**, 400 E. Holding Avenue, Wake Forest, will reopen to the public on **Saturday, June 1, 2013**. The library will resume its normal business hours from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on that Saturday.

The library closed last month to undergo a minor renovation which included new carpet, paint and furnishings. A new floor plan has been incorporated to make using the library easier and more intuitive for library visitors.

The Friends of the Wake Forest Community Library will host a celebration for the library's reopening on Saturday, June 1, 2013. The event will include several activities:

- 10:30 a.m.-1:30 p.m. – Ebony Child face painters

Normal library business hours are Monday through Thursday from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., Friday from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Saturday from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.
