### **WORK SESSION TO DISCUSS COUNTY MANAGER RECRUITMENT**

The Wake County Board of Commissioners will hold a special work session **Monday, August 19, 2013, 11:30 a.m., in room 2800, Wake County Justice Center, 300 S. Salisbury Street, Raleigh**, to discuss the recruitment process for a new county manager. In late July, Wake County Manager David Cooke told Commissioners he would be retiring at the end of November.
