CCBI REQUESTS PUBLIC COMMENT FOR ACCREDITATION

[Raleigh/Wake City-County Bureau of Identification \(CCBI\)](#) is currently accredited by the [Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. \(CALEA\)](#), a credentialing authority seeking to improve the delivery of public safety services. To maintain this accreditation, a team of assessors from CALEA will examine all aspects of CCBI policies and procedures, management, operations, and support services Sunday, December 8, 2013.

As part of the on-site assessment for accreditation, members of the community are invited to offer comments at a public information session **Monday, December 9, 2013, 7-8 p.m., at the Wake County Detention Center, first floor conference room, 3301 Hammond Road, Raleigh.** Verification that CCBI meets CALEA's state-of-the-art standards is part of a voluntary process to gain accreditation.
