WAKE OPENS NEW BAY LEAF FIRE STATION

Wake County Commissioners and the Bay Leaf Volunteer Fire Department Board of Directors held the Opening Ceremony and Ribbon Cutting for the new Bay Leaf Fire Station 1 today, October 20, 2013, at 2 p.m., 11713 Six Forks Road, Raleigh.

In 2012, County Commissioners approved the appropriation of \$3,445,000 for the schematic design and reconstruction of Bay Leaf Fire Station 1. The new 2-story, 16,400 square foot building has a code compliant sleeping area, training space to accommodate up to 70 people and administrative offices. The new station also provides three full-length and one-half length storage bays for fire trucks.

The Bay Leaf Volunteer Fire Department serves the Bay Leaf Fire Insurance District in Northern Wake County from three fire stations. The Bay Leaf Fire Insurance District is 36.03 miles in area and includes a population exceeding 23,600 citizens.
